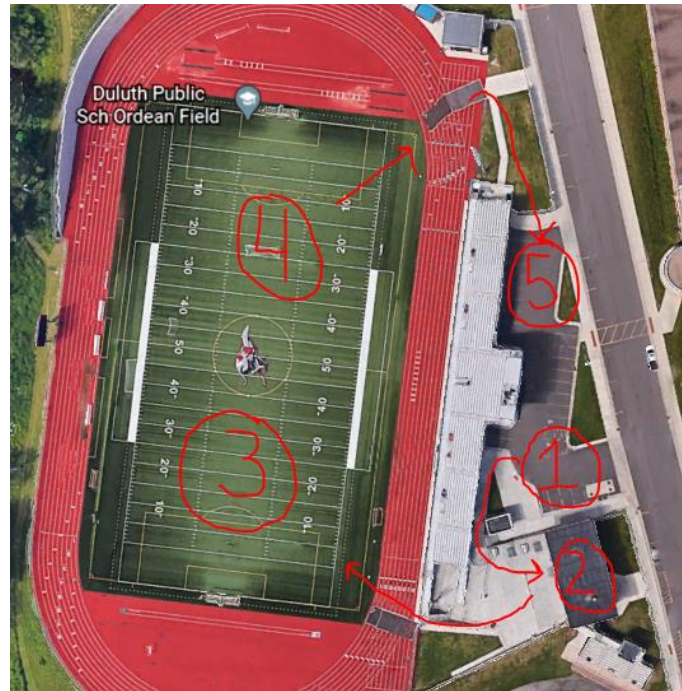


ESS Tryout Procedure



The following flow will be used for tryouts on 10/28 and 10/31. This must be followed in order to tryout.

Area 1- Dropoff Point- Please drop your kids off in the parking lot closest to the ticket window. Players should proceed up the ramp for check-in. Parents of players 13 and older should not leave their cars. If parents of players 12 and under wish to help check their son/daughter in they may walk with them to checkpoint 2 but must return to their car following check-in.

Area 2- Check-in Point- Each player at tryouts must check-in with Steve Polkowski in the garage between the concessions stand and the bathrooms (we will not have access to the bathrooms). Parents will not be allowed past this point.

Area 3-4- Tryout Pods- At check-in pods (if necessary) will be assigned. Players should report immediately to the proper position on the field.

Area 5- Pickup Point- At the conclusion of tryouts players will exit the opposite side of the field to ensure there is no crossing of players in different groups. Players should be picked up by parents in the parking lot to ensure safety on Greyhound Drive.

Additional Tryout Procedures-

- If a player is feeling any symptom of Covid-19 you should not attend tryouts and a makeup should be scheduled with Steve Polkowski. Please email him if this situation applies to you (coachstevepolkowski@gmail.com).
- Players are only allowed to check-in 15 minutes prior to tryouts, this is to make sure the field is cleared from previous sessions.
- Masks must be worn when entering the facility, during warmups, if on a bench during scrimmages and when exiting the facility.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available at check-in and exit for those not wearing gloves.
 - Players should bring their own soccer balls to tryouts.
- Social distancing must be maintained during all phases of check-in, exiting and when possible during tryouts.
